**Speaker Bio**

Dr. Rhonda Switzer graduated from the dental program from the University of Manitoba, Canada in 1991. Since then, she has spent her career overseeing dental programs for the poor. She served as head of dentistry at a fly-in health center in the sub-arctic location of Churchill, Manitoba. She also worked as a staff dentist for the Department of Health in Hamilton, Bermuda where she treated children of low-income families, people with mental disabilities, and people in nursing homes and prisons.

Dr. Switzer became the first employee of the Interfaith Dental Clinic in Nashville, Tennessee in 1995 and has served as the executive director ever since. During her tenure, the clinic has grown from a two-chair operation located in a church basement to a ten-chair clinic with a staff of sixteen, seeing more than 1500 patients each year in a newly expanded 7,500 square foot facility and providing over \$2,366,000 in patient services to the citizens of eight counties in Middle Tennessee.
