The Rotary Foundation's Group Study Exchange

The GSE program is a unique cultural and vocational exchange opportunity for businesspeople and professionals between the ages of 25 and 40 who are in the early stages of their careers. The program provides travel grants for teams to exchange visits in paired areas of different countries.

A candidate for a Group Study Exchange (GSE) team must currently be employed full-time in any recognized business or profession and must have worked in his or her vocational field for at least two years by the time of application. Candidates must also plan to remain in the workforce for a considerable amount of time after the exchange, so that the travel experience will have a significant impact on their professional careers. They must be between the ages of 25 and 40 at the time of application and a citizen of the country in which they reside. They must either be employed or reside in the sending district.
