<p>Ray and Associates will be in Sumner County on Wednesday and Thursday this week holding several "community forums" to gather public input on the characteristics profile of what Sumner Countians are looking for in their next Director. Knowing the community spirit and leadership common among Rotarians, they find great success in meeting with Rotarians because "generally they exhibit a pretty good cross-section of a community".</p>															
<p>Ray and Associates will conduct a two way conversation with our club. They will bring with them a characteristics profile and ask for input from the club. This should last about 45-50 minutes. This is the opportunity for community members to say whether they feel the next Director should be from inside the county or someone with a fresh start from outside the county, should that person be a traditional candidate with a background in teaching or a non-traditional person with a background in management, organizational planning, budgeting, etc.</p>
